Caledonia (IL) Primitive Baptist Church files:

Nancy Clark THOMPSON was born in Belmont County, Ohio, January 8, 1834. When a child she, with her parents, moved from Ohio to Indiana, later to Illinois, and finally, nine years ago, to Wichita, Kansas, which continue to be her home until death. She was married to William A. THOMPSON in December 1851 in Indiana. To this union ten children, six sons and four daughters, were born. Surviving are Mrs. Hattie HARTENBOWER, Mrs. Mary ELDER, J.F., G.B., Miss Viola, and Miss Anna. Her husband, Elder William A. THOMPSON, was a Primitive Baptist preacher for forty-nine years; and after nearly sixty years of happy wedded life, went to his reward, September 24, 1911. The subject of this sketch passed away June 17, 1915. Funeral services were conducted in Wichita, and burial was in the Wichita Cemetery.

Notes for William Allen THOMPSON:

Was a Primitive Baptist minister for 49 years. Preached near Caledonia in Putnam Co, IL; Elmwood in Peoria Co, IL; maybe near Springfield, Sangamon Co, IL. He retired and lived on a farm near Springfield in the area now covered by Lake Springfield. The farm was last owned by Dr. Earl Hartenbower, William's grandson.

The Primitive Baptist church in Caledonia, Putnam Co, IL where he was a preacher for several years stood until 1936 at Caledonia. It was torn down and the lumber was used to build a garage for the Methodist parsonage in Magnolia, IL.

Obit from Caledonia (IL) Church (Baptist) files:

Elder William A. THOMPSON was born May 26, 1831, in the state of Virginia and died at his home in Wichita, Kansas, September 24, 1911. His younger life was spent in Indiana. He came to Putnam Co, Ill., in 1861, and to his farm north of Tonica in 1876. He removed to Springfield (IL) in 1892, and the last five years has lived at Wichita, Kansas. He is survived by his wife and seven children. He was a typical pioneer preacher--large of build with a strong voice and easy flow of language. He was forceful in his utterances and noted for long and argumentative discourses. He also engaged in farming, as he was not a believer in a salaried ministry, but preached the gospel without charge.

SANDY CREEK

Sandy Creek Church was organized at Ox Bow (later called Caledonia), Illinois, on Saturday, September 3, 1836. The first pastor was Elder James B. Chenowith (1800-1866), a native of Berkeley County, Virginia, who settled in the area of Tiskilwa in May 1835. He served Sandy Creek Church, with great success, for many years. An interesting tribute to Elder Chenowith, including an account of the unusual events which led him to serve the church, appears on pages 197-198 of Bradsby's History of Bureau County, Illinois, 1885.

The charter members were William E. Larkin, John Brumsey, Joseph Ash, Joel Corbell, Isaac D. Glenn, Rachel Larkin, Elizabeth Ash, Miriam Graves, and Sarah Glenn. They were organized into a church by Elders James B. Chenowith and Jeriel Root, and Deacon Jesse Sawyer.

Membership statistics of Sandy Creek Church, as recorded in association minutes, show that the Church grew gradually from its original nine charter members, until it reached a membership of 62 in 1877. The small membership, however, was not indicative of the influence of the church in the community. Sandy Creek Church hosted the Sangamon Association in 1845, the annual meetings of which in those days were considered community events, and the attendance was always several thousand people. This continued to be true after the Sandy Creek Association was formed. The association meetings were usually held in a large grove of trees. A wooden platform and pulpit was erected for the preaching, and log planks for the audience. Visitors by the hundreds camped out in the homes, barns and other buildings of the members. Some of the ablest Primitive Baptist ministers in the country, e.g., Elder Sylvester Hassell (1842-1928) of North Carolina, (a noted historian, editor, pastor, and professor of Greek and other languages) attended the Sandy Creek Association during the fifty years of its existence.

The worship services of Sandy Creek Church were conducted according to the simple new testament pattern, i.e., singing of hymns, prayer, preaching, and fellowship. The preaching has been described by some who have written about the church in recent years as being "long and boring," or "two or three hours in length, rambling, tiresome and inclined to ranting." No doubt by the standards of many today that would be considered true; but many today want "preacherettes delivering sermonettes to Christianettes." This certainly would not have been true of the Apostles, and it was not true of the ministers who preached at Sandy Creek Church and Association.

Presumably the early meetings of Sandy Creek Church were held in the pioneer homes of the members, or in schools, or even more likely, in the fort at Caledonia. The early members were pioneer settlers who experienced first-hand the terrors and privations of living in a frontier wilderness with a temporary fort for protection during the Blackhawk War days. On February 13, 1856, George Hiltabrand, Hiram Allen, and Nathaniel Harris, trustees of the church, entered into an indenture whereby Lots 3 and 4 in Block Number 1 in Caledonia were purchased for \$25.00 from Asahel Hannum and his wife Catherine. According to one account, the meeting house was erected on the northeast corner of Block 1. This building has been described as "a frame structure, painted white, which resembled the old New England meeting houses."

As stated above Elder James B. Chenowith was the first pastor. He was followed by Elder Robert F. Haynes, who was living at Ox-Bow and serving the church as pastor in 1858. Still later, Elder William A. Thompson (1831-1911) was chosen pastor. During the period of his pastoral care, the church reached its peak numerical strength. Several ministers held membership in Sandy Creek Church, including Elders William E. Larkin, Bonham Kester, Jesse Kester, Ezra Stout, Isom

Cranfill, Robert F. Haynes, Oran S. Thompson, and James W. Thompson. Elders Larkin and Cranfill moved to Clackamas Co., Oregon, in 1847; Elder Ezra Stout moved to Oregon in 1852; Elder Bonham Kester had moved to lowa by 1852; Elder Jesse Kester died in 1856.

When the Sandy Creek Association met at Hope on September 9, 1887, two letters were presented, each bearing the name of Sandy Creek Church. Both letters were read, but "by unanimous vote received the letter read by I. M. Stansell as the letter from Sandy Creek Church.

Shortly after 1900 the faction of the church in Caledonia ceased to function as a Primitive Baptist Church. In about 1905 the meeting house was repaired for use as a "union church." Later it was moved to the northwest corner of the crossroads, where it stood until 1936, at which time it was sold and torn down for lumber.

The "Hope branch" of the church, which continued to represent in the Sandy Creek Association, held their services in a meeting house on the farm of Simeon C. Hiltabrand (1826-1909), in Hope township, LaSalle County (See LaSalle County). It was called "Uncle Sim's Church," as he built it and owned it, but allowed the church to use it for their meetings. There was no separate deed for this reason. This building still stands, although it has not been used for regular church services for eighty years. Elders Thomas Gill, Robert F. Haynes, John Downey, Smith Ketchum and perhaps others, preached there. No records of their meetings have been located. The building was also used by the Hiltabrand family for reunions from 1896 until 1936. Later, the pews were given to a church in Magnolia, which burned in 1955.

HARMONY

Harmony Church, at or near Elmwood, was organized in about 1856, with ten charter members, some of whom were Peter Riner and his wife, Margaret Riner, and other members of their family. Harmony Church united with the Sandy Creek Association, and hosted that meeting several times.

Pastors who served this church included Elders James B. Chenowith, R. M. Simmons, Smith Ketchum, and probably a few more. Elders Smith Ketchum, Robert F. Haynes, and William A. Thompson all held membership in this church at least for a time.

It appears that the church did not own a meeting house of their own, but met in homes, or a school, or some other building.

Harmony Church continued to represent in the Sandy Creek Association as late as 1897, when the association ceased to exist. In 1897, Harmony Church reported 15 members. We have not been able to determine when the church dissolved, or stopped holding worship services, but Elder Ketchum, the pastor, moved to Nebraska in 1902, and was called back to conduct funerals of some of the members after that date. Meetings had probably become irregular or ceased by 1904.

In Hennepin township, January 15, by Rev. O. S. Thompson, George L. Hartenbower and Miss Hattie M. Thompson, daughter of the officiating clergyman. (Note: George's middle initial was "F" for Fisher; Hattie's father was a clergyman but his name was William A. Thompson and he did not perform the marriage ceremony).

George was described by his granddaughters, Vinta Mae Wright Kreider and Harriett Hartenbower Mitchell as "a kind, sweet man". He loved his family very much. When his daughter, Vinta Anna, completed 8th grade at Hope Center School in LaSalle Co, IL, George decided to retire from farming and move to Bloomington, IL where he believed his children would have a better opportunity for a good education. Subsequently, he bought a home at 608 East Walnut Street and oldest child, Vinta Anna, enrolled at Bloomington High School. He was a Tech 5 who mustered in January 1943 at Canton, IL, He went to Chicago, then to Newport News, VA and began basic training in central Florida. Clair really disliked this experience not only because it was the military but because of the climate. The soldiers were bothered greatly by sand fleas. He never cared much for the State of Florida thereafter but did make a trip there in the early 1970's and attended the opening of Walt Disney World in Orlando. Clair was chosen for special training at Fort Benning in Columbus GA during the summer of 1943. Vinta Mae was able to join him for the summer in Georgia before he was sent overseas. Clair's special training allowed him to avoid front line action and for that he felt very fortunate. From Georgia, Clair went first to North Africa and then to Italy where he spent the remainder of the war. Clair was among the last people drafted and that was due to his age. He served under General Mark Clark. After the war's end, he remained on active duty in Italy and was allowed to travel throughout both Italy and Switzerland. He mustered out in the summer of 1946 in Chicago having traveled back to the United States aboard the HMS Queen Mary. While the exact nature of Clair's wartime military life is not known at this time. I know that he worked in some capacity with prisoners of war, supplies, and communications.

Clair Learned manual arts at Avon High School and did excellent woodworking during his life (as a hobby). He was very well read lots and loved to travel. He was always ready for "adventure" and planned many spur of the moment activities for his children such as picnics, skating/sledding parties at Avondale Lake, etc. Clair was an avid basketball fan and enjoyed both collegiate and IL high school basketball but he didn't like professional sports at all. Personally, Clair was an excellent basketball playerwhile in high school. He was very fast which compensated for his 5'6" stature. Clair had a great sense of humor and loved practical jokes. He and his friend Paul Moore and sometimes Fred Janes did lots of crazy things such as inviting Adolph Hitler to the Prairie City Picnic. Clair said as a result of getting no response from Hitler, so they had a low opinion of him, thereafter!. On several occasions, he and Paul would go into a place that had jukeboxes and Paul, who had a key to jukeboxes would use the key to secretly turn up the volume and then they'd leave. As a youth, Clair showed his adventuresome spirit by trying to shoot a shotgun shell out of a bb gun. Obviously, it didn't work as the gun backfired and left Clair with a bloody leg. He passed out from the expeirence and was carried by his pals into his mother's house and put on the dining room table and Dr. Davis was called. Naturally, Clair's mother was beside herself. Dr. Davis calmly removed the shell from Clair's knee and told Grandma 'boys will be boys' and left. However, a piece of blue jean material remained in Clair's knee for the rest of his life. There is an AVON SENTINEL article about the shooting incident. Clair loved carsand always had a new (or relatively new) one. When he married, he told Vinta Mae that the only thing he loved most next to her was his car! Clair had his first "car" when he was about 10 years old----it was 4 wheels, frame, and engine. The passengers and driver sat on the gas tank covered with a rug! Clair grew up in Avon. His neighborhood gang included Barbara DAVIS, Giles DAVIS, Doris Lemon, Lach Crissey, Winston (Murph) Crissey, Donald Hatch (the musician), and the Gillett girls --particularly Catherine (Cak) and Donna (Did). Bob Trumpy was a great friend and father figure to Clair. Bob was also a prankster to a degree and much to the chagrin of their mothers he gave nicknames to many of the town kids--name which remained with them for life. Clair's was "Mum" after "Old Man Mummey" who took things out of trash cans.
