

L. C. Smith 2-1967

L. C. Smith, 86, of Plainfield, died last Thursday in St. Joseph hospital, Joliet, following a brief illness. Mr. Smith was principal of Wenona high school from 1921-28.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon in the Congregational church, Plainfield, with the Rev. Russell Schmidt officiating. Burial was in the Plainfield cemetery.

Mr. Smith was born in Plainfield and for the past 16 years had served as tax assessor. Prior to his retirement in 1930, he was a teacher and superintendent in various Illinois School Districts, including Wenona.

He was a member of Plainfield Lodge 536 A. F. and A. M. He also was a member of the Plainfield Congregational church.

Mr. Smith was preceded in death by his wife, Flora Mae, in 1964. He is survived by two sons, Harold of Plainfield and L. Wayne of Kenosha, Wis.; six grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and two sisters, Mrs. Dennison Green of Bloomington and Mrs. Mark Green of Plainfield.
